

PRIVATE GUIDED FOUR WHEEL DRIVE DAY TOURS

TO THE LAGOON JOKULSARLON - FROM REYKJAVÍK

- Pick up at your hotel.
- Driving distance ca. 700 km.
- Duration ca. 12 - 13 hours.

The day tour from Reykjavik to the lagoon Jokulsarlon is a long day tour which offers a magnificent and diverse experience of Icelandic nature. The black sand beaches, the ocean and the coastline, the glaciers, the birdlife and the nation's history are just examples of what you will experience during this tour. We begin the day by driving from Reykjavik passing Hellisheidi Power Plant. There we will receive information from our guide about the country's unique geology and how Icelanders harness geothermal energy in an environmentally friendly way. From there we drive towards east and throughout the historical area Rangarvallasysla, the setting of the medieval saga Njalssaga. We will stop at Hvolsvollur for a while and then drive to Seljalandsfoss, a beautiful high waterfall we can walk behind. From there we continue the trip to Skogar, where there is another big waterfall, Skogafoss. Now we drive to Dyrholaey, a promontory reaching out into the ocean, displaying magnificent birdlife. From Dyrholaey we drive to Vik at Myrdal where we can visit a souvenir shop, which specializes in woolen clothes. Now we drive to Kirkjubaejarklaustur and then further east and over the glacier river Skeidara. The highest peak in Iceland, Oraefajokull is there dominating the nature and from there we drive to the glacier lagoon, Jokulsarlon. After ca. one hour stop we return to Reykjavik via the same route.



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The tour setup and schedule:

- 08:00 From Reykjavik.
- 08:20 Arrival at Hellisheidi Power Plant.
- 09:20 Arrival at Hvolsvollur.
- 09:30 Departure from Hvolsvollur.
- 10:00 Arrival at Seljalandsfoss.
- 10:30 Arrival at Skogafoss.
- 11:00 Arrival at Dyrholaey.
- 11:15 Departure from Dyrholaey.
- 11:45 Arrival at Vik in Myrdal.
- 12:00 Departure from Vik in Myrdal.
- 13:00 Arrival at Kirkjubaejarklaustur
- 14:00 Arrival at Skaftafell.
- 15:00 Arrival at the lagoon, Jokulsarlon.
- 16:00 Departure from Jokulsarlon.
- 21:00 Arrival at Reykjavik.

The tourist guides that are guiding for Iceland South Coast Travel are members at the Iceland Tourist Guide Association. The vehicles are comfortable and well equipped where the driver is also the guide (driver - guide).

We recommend group sizes of 2 - 6 persons per tour.

Prices to the lagoon Jokulsarlon from Reykjavik:

- 6 pax = 27.600 ISK = ca. 180 € per person.
- 5 pax = 28.900 ISK = ca. 188 € per person.
- 4 pax = 31.000 ISK = ca. 202 € per person.
- 3 pax = 33.400 ISK = ca. 218 € per person.

Children 0 - 12 = 50% discount.
